1. Applicant Qualifications

- 1.1 An applicant must have completed high school or passed an equivalent high school standard test or be currently in their final year of high school (including, Grade 12 in the US system or Year 13 in the British/IB system).
- 1.2 An applicant from abroad must have a high school certificate, or have passed the high school equivalent standard test (GED, IGCSE) must have the Equivalence Certificate from High School Certificate Equivalency System. (http://www.hsces.atc.chula.ac.th/)
- 1.3 An applicant must possess a history of good behavior and agree to abide strictly by existing and any further Chulalongkorn University regulations, codes and policies.

2. Application Requirements

- 2.1 Three of one-inch (l") photographs
- 2.2 Academic transcript(s); and in case of high school completion, a copy of a diploma from the school must also be submitted. In case of being currently in the final year of high school, a copy of official document certifying academic status from the applicant's school is also required.
- 2.3 Three test results of English, mathematics, and Test of Aptitude in Design that are not older than two years; with each meeting the score requirements below.

- 2.4 A portfolio, a personal archive of art, craft, design, and experimentation exhibiting creative and/or critical thinking and process.
- 2.5 A copy of passport
- 2.6 An application form completed online by the applicant.

3. Evaluation

The criteria of admission is based on the applicant, s qualifications accompanying documents stated in items 2.3 and 2.4, an interview and an English writing test. The weights assigned to the 6 requirements are as follows:

• English Test Result	20%
• Mathematics Test Result	15%
• CU-TAD Result	20%
• Portfolio	10%
• Interview	25%
• English writing test	10%

INDA PORTFOLIO GUIDE

PORTFOLIO:

- 1. The Purpose of the portfolio is to demonstrate your individual, artistic, design, and critical thinking abilities as well as your organizational and communication skills. The contents of the portfolio should demonstrate your interests, versatility, and proficiency through different types of media and projects- sketching, painting, collage, photography, design, experimentation, etc. Architectural representations as perspectives and renderings are neither required nor compulsory.
- 2. The portfolio reveals a great deal about the applicant. It must contain original works or works with properly credited references only. Be critical with what is included. Select only the most relevant images that intently represent your skills, passions, creative sensibilities, personal pursuits, outlook in learning, and critical thinking processes. Recommended maximum number of works is six. Please refrain from including personal or family photos that are irrelevant to your work.
- 3. Special attention must be paid to the legibility of images and texts, especially in the areas of resolution, contrast, and sharpness.
- 4. The required format of the portfolio is a digital PDF file not exceeding 50 MB, stored and shared online by the applicant then submitted as a URL link in the online application form. The portfolio size is A4 with <u>no more than 20 pages including covers</u>. Portfolios not meeting these requirements will automatically be rejected.
- 5. The portfolio and all its contents have to be original works executed by the applicant and must not be plagiarized through any means, partial or whole. Suspects of any plagiarism will automatically be disqualified.

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
